



A Tribute to Dr. B.P.Rao by the Hon. Secretary

Eighty nine years old Dr. B.P. Rao (Badida Padmanabha Rao) passed away peacefully in his sleep in the early hours of 11th March, 2015 at his son's residence in Mumbai.

Dr. B.P. Rao was born in 1926 at Machilipatnam. He did his B.Com Hons. From Andhra University and M.Com., L.L.B., Ph.D. from Lucknow University. He joined Osmania University as a lecturer in commerce in 1949.

Dr. Rao was the Principal of the Prestigious Nizam College from 1984 to 1986 till his retirement.

Dr. B.P. Rao was a great educationalist -A very learned man with an extraordinary gift of memory. I would be amazed to hear from him about each of his students, their name and year of study, and in many cases even their present occupation. He has written eight books on Merchantile Law.

Dr. B.P. Rao selflessly served the Hyderabad Children's Aid Society since 1960. He was the Hon. Treasurer from 1960 to 1990 when he honestly and efficiently managed all money matters. During his tenure money grew and many essential projects were taken up.

After the sad demise of Mrs. Tehminabai Dhage in 1990 Dr. Rao became the Hon. Secretary of Hyderabad Children's Aid Society and held this Post till 1998. During this period he started the V.K. Dhage Special Coaching Center for the 150 inmates of Radha Kishan Homes to impart value based education. He then became the Vice-President of Hyderabad Children's Aid Society in 1998. Though he shifted to his native place in Machilipatnam his moral support and guidance was always with us. Till the end the children and staff of the Society were close to his heart. He was an example of simple living and high thinking.

The suffering which he went through in 2001 for the children of the Society will never be forgotten.

Dr. B.P. Rao will always be respectfully remembered as a man of strong will – Honest – outspoken – and as a devoted father figure.

In his passing away humanity has lost a good human being.

May God give strength to his family to bare this irreparable loss. We pray – May his soul rest in Peace!

AN INTRODUCTION TO HYDERABAD CHILDREN'S AID SOCIETY (1950 – 2015)

The Hyderabad Children's Aid Society is a Charitable Voluntary Organization established in 1950 (Regd No.18 of 1950). The Society runs four homes for the purpose of good administration.

The Radha Kishan Home for children under 9 years, the Radha Kishan Home for Small Boys under the age of 10 years and the Radha Kishan Balika Bhavan for girls in the age group of 10 to 18 years are all situated at Nanalnagar. The Vejbai Bal Nivas for older boys is at Shivarampally. The children residing in the four homes are between the age of 5 to 18 years. All the children go to school or college. At Nanalnagar we have the English Medium V.K. Dhage School registered by the Government of Telangana up to class VII.

Our academic performance is good and the Board exam results are encouraging. Children are encouraged to take part in sports, Art and Crafts and all extracurricular activities. Some children go to private schools outside the premises. At present we have 272 children in the four homes.

200 at Nanalnagar and 72 are in Shivarampally.

Every year one health camp, one Eye Camp and one dental camp are conducted.

We have an Hon. Doctor, a Moral Science Teacher and a Yoga Teacher who visit the Homes every week. The main aim of the Society is to give a happy childhood and value based education to poor destitute and orphan children.

The children are sheltered in airy spacious buildings with a big playground served Nutritious food and given decent clothing free of cost.

All festivals are celebrated in traditional style.

All this is possible with the help of donors, sponsors and well-wishers at home and abroad who contribute generously in cash and kind.

Without this help we would not be able to carry on the noble work of the founder couple Shri Venkat Krishnaji Dhage and Smt. Tehminabai Dhage who dedicated their whole life for the betterment of the underprivileged children of the Society.

Hyderabad Children's Aid Society has a rich history to be proud of; The Radha Kishan Home was inaugurated by Dr. Sarvepally Radha Krishnan the Radha Kishan Balika Bhavan was inaugurated by Pandit Jawaharlal Nehru, Dr. Rajendra Pershad the 1st President of Independent India, Shri Lal Bahadur Sastry, Shri P.V. Narasimha Rao Ex-Prime Ministers have all visited the homes and blessed the children.

Dr. Neelam Sanjeeva Reddy former President of India was the President of Hyderabad Children's Aid Society from 1962-1967.

All these great personalities have inspired us to keep the Lamp burning.

Our Children 2014-2015

In the year 2014-2015 the Society has sheltered 272 under privileged children 200 at the RadhaKishan Homes and 72 at Vejbai Bal Nivas. The Society caters to free food, clothing, shelter and value based education. The aim is to give these children a happy childhood. The Boys and girls sheltered by the Society are between the age of 5 to 18 years.

Four Homes run by the Society:-

- 1. Radha Kishan Home, (H.No. 9-4-78 & 79, Nanalnagar, Hyderabad-500 008) for children between the ages 5-9 years shelters 28 children.
- 2. Radha Kishan Home for Small Boys, (H.No. 9-4-78 & 79, Nanalnagar, Hyderabad-500 008) between the ages of 5-10 shelters 32 boys.
- 3. Radha Kishan Balika Bhavan, (H.No. 9-4-78 & 79, Nanalnagar, Hyderabad-500 008) for girls between the ages of 10-18 years shelters 140 girls.
- 4. Vejbai Bal Nivas, (Opp Z.P. High School, Shivarampally, Near National Police Academy, Hyderabad-500 052) for boys at Shivarampally shelters 72 boys between the age of 11-18 years.

Children who stayed back in the May month attended a Camp conducted by Nachiketa Tapovan from 3rd to 10th May.



A picnic to Sanghi Temple was sponsored by Mrs. Beena Bhandari to whom we are thankful.


