1 girl Bachelor of Commerce with Computers (B.Com, Computers)

2 girls Bachelor of Fine Arts (BFA)

3 girls Master of Business Administration (MBA)

This year 1 boy completed Masters of Medical Bio-Chemistry and is now financially independent.

The 250 children in the four homes run by Hyderabad Children's Aid Society are all going to School Or College.

They are all healthy and happy. A regular doctor is attached to the Homes along with a Medico Nurse to take care of children's health.

Once a year a Mega Health Camp is conducted which includes E.N.T., Eye and Dental Check-up. Health issues are on priority list.

Our V.K.Dhage (English Medium) School is now recognized by the Government of Telangana upto class VII. The school caters to value based education and encourages children to participate in Sports and Extra Curricular Activities.

On 25th January, 2014 Annual Day was celebrated. Children of all four homes participated in ten group dances of different states of India. The performance was colourful and spectacular and was enjoyed by a large crowd.

19th October, 2014 was a very sad day. When Miss Shashikala Joshi passed away after a brief illness. Miss Joshi will be lovingly remembered by all, for her sincere service rendered for 40 long years. Many children now living in Denmark were brought up by her with motherly Love and care.

On the whole the four Homes are running smoothly. The children are comfortable and happy with the help of thoughtful people like you who look beyond the horizon of their own homes.
