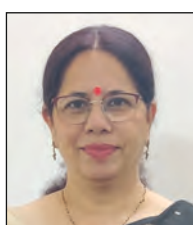

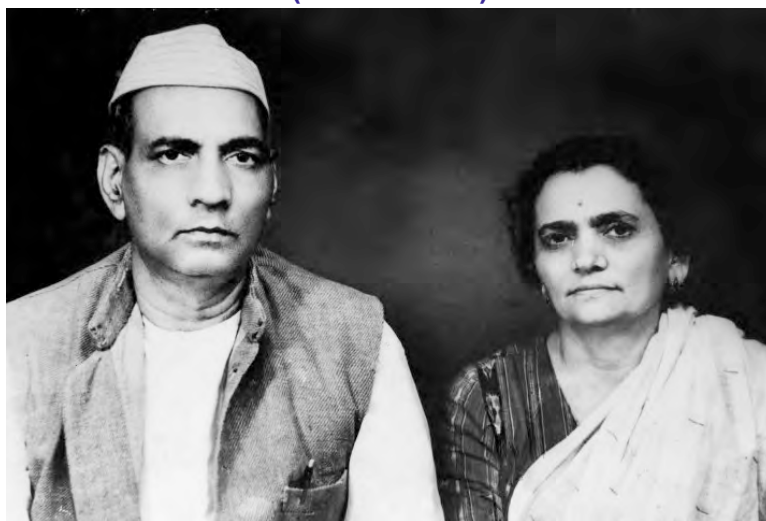

# AN INTRODUCTION TO HYDERABAD CHILDREN'S AID SOCIETY (1950 – 2022)

The Hyderabad Children's Aid Society is a Charitable Voluntary Organization established in 1950 (Regd No.18 of 1950). The Society runs three homes:

**The Radha Kishan Home** for small girls under 7 to 12 years.

**Radha Kishan Balika Bhavan** for girls in the age group of 13 to 18 years, all situated at Nanal Nagar.

**The Vejbai Bal Nivas** for boys at Shivarampally.

The children residing in the three homes are of the age group 7 to 18 years.

At Nanal Nagar, the home has V.K. Dhage School (English Medium) recognized by the Government of Telangana up to class VII. vide letter no 964/D5/ETR/2015 DATED 24-01-2015.

Health camps, eye camp and dental camp are regularly conducted.

The Society has a dedicated team to help in serving the three homes - Hon. Doctor, moral science teacher, social worker, Karate teacher, well trained nurse, dedicated teachers, sincere staff, helping ayahs and a Yoga teacher.

## **Aim:**

To give a happy childhood and value based education to poor, destitute and orphan children.

## **Infrastructure:**

The children are sheltered in airy spacious buildings with big playgrounds They are served nutritious food and are given decent clothing, free of cost.

All this is possible with the help of our donors, sponsors and well-wishers at home and abroad who contribute generously in cash and kind. Without their help we would not be able to carry on the noble work of the founder couple **Shri Venkat Krishnaji Dhage and Smt. Tehminabai Dhage**, who dedicated their whole life for the betterment of the underprivileged children of the Society.

Hyderabad Children's Aid Society has a rich history to be proud of. The Radha Kishan Home was inaugurated by Dr. Sarvepally Radha Krishnan. The Radha Kishan Balika Bhavan was inaugurated by Pandit Jawaharlal Nehru. Dr. Rajendra Prasad the First President of Independent India, Shri Lal Bahadur Sastry and Shri P.V. Narasimha Rao Ex-Prime Ministers have all visited the homes and blessed the children.

Dr. Neelam Sanjeeva Reddy former President of India was the President of Hyderabad Children's Aid Society from 1962-1967.

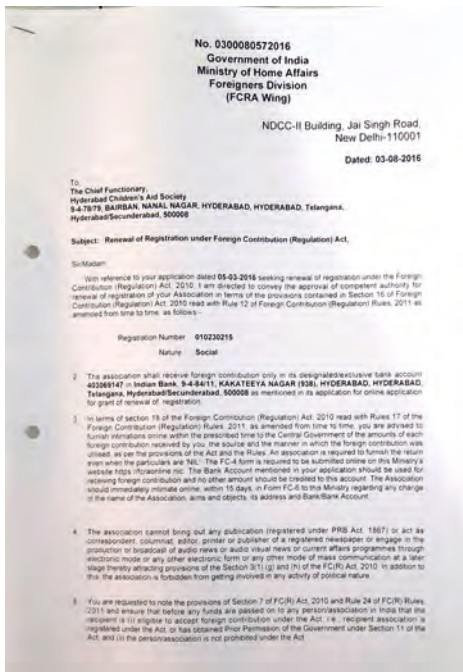

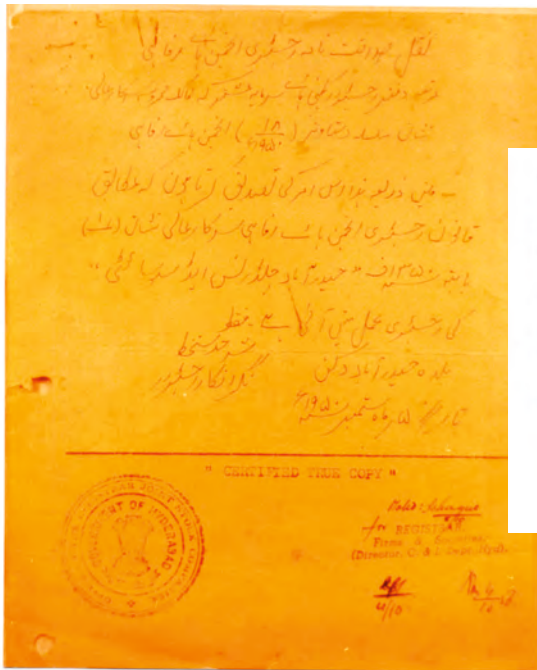
